Prior to the half term break, the whole school took part in the Specialist 'Diversity' Week, focusing on our differences, learning about each other's cultures, languages and religions. The week was a wonderful experience for everyone, as we had the opportunity to learn and understand why it important to be inclusive no matter what colour we are, disability we may have or faith we believe in. We will be continuing with our fantastic topic by writing our own information books called 'ships of the time'. We also have Easter fun planned as well as designing and making our own ships. In Maths, our focus is 2D and 3D shapes and an introduction to fractions, whilst in English, we will be using our research skills to find out information to find out how ships have changed over time and what they have and are used for.

In science we will continue to learn a little more about materials by choosing and using the right ones to design and make a floating ship and one that is waterproof. We will then be moving on to learn about plants, how well they grow in different conditions, and we may well grow our own too! We are excited to learn how to observe and draw boats/ships using pencil, paint and charcoal in our Art and Design lessons too.

In Music we are continuing to listen with concentration and understanding to a range of highquality live and recorded music and we will create and perform our own chanted rhythm patterns and sea shanties.
