### **English**

In English we will be using a new and exciting text called 'Traction Man'. An adventurous story that will inspire and stimulate ideas to help your children write interestingly.

We will also use a story called 'A House for a Hermit Crab' by Eric Carle alongside information books and other stories with familiar settings to write tongue-twisters, stories and diary entries.

## Maths

In Maths, we will be revising multiplication and then moving on to division and measurement. We will also consolidate our addition and subtraction knowledge and apply these skills in solving worded problems. Please do not hesitate to ask about the methods that are taught and how you can help at home.

### **Science**

In Science, we will continue to learn about living things and their habitats. We are also going to focus on different sources of food and food chains.

### **Weekly Routines**

PE is on <u>MONDAYS, TUESDAYS</u> and <u>WEDNESDAYS</u> - children should come to school wearing their PE kit. There has been quite a few children who have not had their earrings covered with tape, please <u>ensure</u> this is done before coming to school.

Spellings will be sent home on **<u>Fridays</u>** and the children will be tested on the following **<u>Friday</u>**.

Homework is set on a **Thursday** and is due in by the following **Tuesday**.

## How can you help your child?

- Listen to them read each day. There will be a reading book and library book in their book-bag each week. When they do read to you, please make a note in their reading record (this can be your signature or a short comment).
- Ask them questions about what they have read.
- Encourage them to practise their spellings every day, using the 'LOOK, COVER, WRITE, CHECK' method.
- Support them in completing their homework.
- Go to your local library to find books about their current topic.
- Ensure your child wears their PE kit on the days they have PE lessons.
