Our topic for this term is '**Beachcombers!**' So, pack up some sandwiches, pick up a fishing net and keep your eyes peeled because we are off to the coast to go beachcombing! This half term, we will visit a 'local' beach virtually to experience the sights, sounds and smells of the seashore and explore rock pools to find living and non-living things.

In **English** we will take every opportunity to kick back in a deckchair and do a little reading. We will read a range of seaside stories and use the coast/sea/ocean as settings for our writing. Our focus will start on 'The Snail and the Whale' and 'A House for a Hermit' by Eric Carle, 'The Little Mermaid-Lady Tales' and information books to write labels, lists and captions, tongue-twisters, stories, letters and postcards. We will also use the internet to search for facts about the seashore and use that knowledge to write our own non-fiction texts



In Maths Giraffes will revise place value and work with numbers up to 100, comparing them and using them in number bonds. Then we will move on to the four operations , be introduced to new methods and recap those that they are already familiar with. Please take any opportunity to recognise numbers in any situation, whether it be at the supermarket looking at prices, counting objects in 2s, 5s or 10s or playing a board game!







Weekly Routines

Our PE sessions this year are on <u>Mondays</u>, <u>Tuesdays and Wednesdays</u>. Please make sure the Giraffes come to school <u>wearing</u> the correct PE kit (short or long sleeves and shorts or jogging bottoms/leggings, depending on weather conditions), long hair <u>must</u> be tied up and earrings <u>must</u> be removed or covered with micropore tape <u>before</u> arriving to school. We will also be having Golden Mile on Thursdays and Fridays, but normal uniform should be worn on these days.

Spellings will be sent home on Fridays and the children will be tested on the following Friday.

Homework is set on a <u>Thursday</u> and is due in by the following <u>Tuesday</u>.

Library books will be changed every Wednesday. Please make sure the book is returned on this day, weekly.



- Listen to them read each day. You should all have a log-in for MONSTER PHONICS ebooks and we will be letting you know which Stage and book number they should start at.
- As usual the children will visit the school library once a week so please make sure the book is in their book-bag each week. When they do read to you, please make a note in their reading record (this can be your signature or a short comment).
- Ask them questions about what they have read.
- Encourage them to practise their spellings every day, using the 'LOOK, COVER, WRITE, CHECK' method.
- Support them in completing their homework.
- Go to your local library to find books about their current topic.
