

In **Geography**, using maps and research, we'll locate Buckingham Palace, understand compass directions, plan routes around London and learn about the countries of the United Kingdom.

In Art/ Design and Technology, we'll learn about primary and secondary colours and create abstract art.

In Music, we will learn traditional British songs and nursery rhymes.




Came to Tea

#### How can you help your child?

- Try and listen to your child read every day, if possible, the Monster Phonics books.
- Please make a note in their reading record (this can be your signature or a short comment) to show that your child has read at home.
- Ask them questions about what they have read.
- Encourage them to practise the spellings they have been set every day.
- Support them in completing their homework.
- Help them to practise counting, recognising and writing numbers in numerals and words.
- Please make sure your child has the Spelling Book and the

Reading Record in their bookbag every day.



#### Weekly routines

- PE is on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Please ensure that children come to school
  wearing their PE kit, their earrings are taken off or covered and their long hair is tied
  back.
- Spellings will be sent home each Friday and the children will be tested on the following
   Friday.
- Their homework is set on a Thursday and is due in by the following Tuesday.
- Please provide your child with a named water bottle and name all clothing.
